ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

All tests to be ridden in 20m x 60m sand arena with a side entry. Exhibitors will be notified if the show arena will be available for warm up. Warm up in both indoor and outdoor sand arenas. Lunging available in designated outdoor areas.

Children & Pets

No Dogs please; and for safety, **no unattended children.**

Food

Concessions will be available on grounds.

Stabling

\$35/night, very limited onsite stabling to be filled on a first come, first served basis. 12' x 12' box stalls with full doors, first bedding included.

AWARDS

Prizes for first (classes with 3+ riders), ribbons first to sixth place.

The American Connemara Pony Society will provide a ribbon for the Connemara or half-bred with the highest average score (minimum 60%). Proof of registration and ACPS membership must accompany entry form.

The Arabian Horse Association (Region 4) will provide a rosette for the highest score earned by a registered Arabian, Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian. Proof of registration must accompany entry form.

DIRECTIONS

Horse Butte Equestrian Center (at the corner of Arnold Market and Horse Butte Rd): I-97, exit East (towards Hollywood video) on Reed Market Road, turn South (right) on 27th St, turn left on Rickard Rd. (½ mile). Continue approx 2 miles, turn right on Billadeau Rd. At Stop sign, turn left on Arnold Market Rd, show grounds parking is immediately on the right, follow signs. HBEC- 541-388-2820.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be sent by e-mail, or phoned if there's no email address. Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you would prefer to have ride times mailed to you. Classes may be split or combined at the show management's discretion. Management reserves the right to limit the number of rides per rider (as a one day show).
