*2. Intro A & B and Training 1&2 will be ridden in the small arena (20mx40m) unless informed otherwise.

*3. Class 103, Maiden Horse/Rider Combination- For horse/rider combination that has not won a blue ribbon at any dressage competition at any level.

*4. Amateur riders only according to US Equestrian rules.

*5. Rider is responsible for providing management with a boom box or music player.

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Horse Butte: Two indoor arenas and one outdoor arena, all with sand footing. Round Pen. Main show arena is lighted indoor arena. Intro tests will be either in the other indoor arena or in the outdoor arena, depending on weather. Lungeing in designated areas only.

Stonepony: Warm-up in covered arena, sand/rubber footing. Show arena in outdoor arena, sand footing. Round Pen. No lungeing in warm-up arena

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Will be sent by e-mail (telephone as second choice.). *If you prefer to receive information by telephone, please specify, otherwise all information- times etc will be emailed.* It is ultimately the responsibility of the rider to get his/her times! As classes may be scheduled out of listed order, riders should be prepared to ride at any time.

VOLUNTEERING

A \$10 Working Rider fee is to be paid for EACH HORSE (members and non members) entered in the show. *Exception:* An owner of up to 2 horses may enter and ride these two horses for one Working Rider fee. **Please send a separate check for each horse made out to COCODS.** For each 2 hours worked by the rider or a suitable substitute, the Working Rider check will be returned. All efforts will be made to schedule rides and jobs so that they are compatible and, where possible, to have stalls available while you work. Entries will not be considered valid unless all competitors pay the fee with their entry. Use section on Entry form for "Other Fees."

Request from Secretary or download the COC-ODS Working Rider form from ODS Website located on the entry form page linked to the Shows & Clinics Calendar - please do not use the volunteer form on the backside of the generic ODS League Entry Form.

OTHER

Copy of ODS card REQUIRED for scores to count toward COC awards, you must declare your affiliation with Central Oregon Chapter to ODS!

A horse/rider combination may only enter each test once (ie you may only ride Training Level Test 1 Maiden, and not Test 1 Amateur also).

Each rider is limited to 6 classes/2 or more horses. If there is room 5 days before the closing date then more classes may be entered at the Secretary's discretion. USEF limits each horse to 3 tests per day

Management reserves all rights.

Horses not entered in the show are NOT allowed on the show grounds.

Riders who are unable to keep their horses under control may be asked to leave the grounds and forfeit all entry fees. Be courteous and consider the safety of others at all times.

Coaching is allowed only from outside the warm-up arena.

Proper show attire is encouraged. Helmet or appropriate dressage hat and boots are required, however half chaps are allowed. US Equestrian rules will be in effect. Tack, bits, whips and spurs will be checked.
