ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Competition arena is inside with mixed sand or hogs fuel footing. Indoor warm-up is mixed sand or hogs fuel footing. Seasonably available outdoor arena is sand. Intro - Training level tests ridden in short arena; First level tests ridden in standard arena.

Food

Coffee, doughnuts, lunch items and snacks available at concession stand.

Stabling

Horse Stall box stalls with full doors	\$20/day

OTHER

Local Show Rules may apply; check with show management. Junior Riders are 17 and under as of December 1, 2007. Dressage Trail is a Training Level type test with trail obstacles interspersed between movements.
