Sand footing; outdoor competition arena 20m x 60m; Training Level may be scheduled in 20m x 40m indoor arena. Indoor and outdoor warm-up areas and lungeing areas.

Camping on grounds

Concessions on grounds, BBQ Saturday night for \$5/per person.

Stabling

Weekend stabling fees: provide separate check payable to Thomason Arena. 12x12 MD permanent stalls \$75 with first bedding. 12x40 w/cover \$40; 12x20 w/cover \$30; 12x20 without cover \$20. Daily Haul-in fee is \$10/day per horse.

AWARDS

Awards to first place, rosettes to third, high score and reserve high score awards in each division. Special Champion Quarter Horse award (please include copy of registration papers).

DIRECTIONS
