QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

This event consists of three shows: an **open show** on Saturday, a **High School Championship Show** and the **ODS League Championship Show** on Saturday/Sunday.

Verification of eligibility must accompany your entry. Submit score sheets and other supporting documentation with entry.

The League Championship committee has decided to support developing interest in not only quadrille, as previously announced, but also for Freestyle and Pas de Deux. As a result, for the 2007 League Championships there will be no qualifying criteria for Freestyle, Pas de Deux or Quadrille. Each Freestyle, Pas de Deux, or Quadrille that enters the Championship show will compete for the Championship. Please be aware that this will probably change for 2008 as the League Show Program is currently being evaluated and we would welcome input.

1. Each horse/rider combination must have at least two qualifying scores from any test of the level at two different ODS League competitions from two different judges to qualify for each level, at a minimum score of 55%.
2. Rider must have been an ODS member at the time the qualifying scores were earned.
3. For the 2007 League Championship Show, qualifying show year is May 1,

2006 through April 30, 2007. Score must be earned in current show year and is not transferable.

4. Only scores received at competitions designated ODS League-approved shows, using an "L" graduate or USEF licensed judge count.
5. Qualifying score must be earned by horse/rider combination; it cannot be earned separately.
6. In order to establish qualification for League Championship classes, qualifying scores must be listed on the back of the entry form and photocopy the front cover of the qualifying test and attach to entry form. Also enclose a copy of your ODS membership card.

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Competition arena is inside with mixed dirt, sand or hogs fuel footing. Indoor warm-up is mixed dirt, sand or hogs fuel footing. Seasonably available outdoor arena. Introductory and Training level tests may be ridden in short arena (20m x 40m); all other tests ridden in standard arena (20m x 60m).

Food

Concession stand.

RV Hookups

Camper Hookups are \$40/weekend for electrical only hookups or \$45/weekend with full hookups.

Stabling

Horse Stall box stalls with full doors and sawdust bedding
\$40/day or \$75/weekend for horse or tack stalls.

AWARDS

Trophies to first place and ribbons to sixth place for the open show on Saturday. Awards to Champion and Reserve Champion and ribbons to eighth place for the League Championship show. High School Teams will receive neck ribbons for team placing and individual riders will receive a Champion and a Reserve Champions award. All horses and riders placing in the championship classes must appear for their presentation ceremony to receive their awards and ribbons. There will be an overall High Point ribbon and award for the horse/rider combination with the highest combined percentage for the open show on Saturday. In the event of a tie for the Champion, the collective marks will determine first, second and/or third places. If collective marks for Champion are equal, the tie will remain unbroken (i.e. two first places will be awarded, next third place, etc.). Only ties for the Championship Show will remain unbroken. Ties after second place will be broken per USEF Article 1923. The Sponsorship Coordinator requests that all First Place, Champion and Reserve Champion winners sign a Thank You note to their respective sponsors; Thank You notes will be located in the show office or awards booth.

CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. Championship classes must be ridden from memory.
2. Whips are not permitted in championship classes.
3. USEF rules for attire are encouraged, however not required. Juniors are required to wear ASTM-SEI approved helmets with harness.

4. Entrants or their designees are required to volunteer (see Volunteering below).
5. In the absence of rules to the contrary, the show will adhere to standards for League shows.
6. Management reserves the right to change show format, cancel or combine classes as entries warrant.

DIRECTIONS

Take exit 258 and then turn south onto Portland Road. Turn left on Lana Avenue, cross Silverton Road and continue straight ahead into Fairgrounds.

LEVELS / DIVISIONS

Horse/Rider combinations may enter two consecutive levels but may only ride in one division (Adult Amateur, Junior/Young Rider, etc.). Refer to USEF rules in regards to Adult Amateur and Junior/Young Rider definitions. High School Championships are a separate show and Jr/YR's may enter the Jr/YR division as well as the High School Championship classes if they have qualified.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be e-mailed and posted on the ODS website (there will be a link from the listing for this show on the "Shows and Clinics" page). It is the competitors responsibility to obtain ride times from the show secretary. Management reserves the right to combine, cancel or reorder classes, add or substitute judges or make any other changes required.

SCORING

Championship scores will be calculated by dividing total points earned in the two tests by the total of the points available in those tests.
