Arenas & Footing

Competition will be held in the outdoor arena if weather permits. New facility owners may update footing between publication date and competition; check ODS website for updated prize list. Competition arena is outside with sand footing or inside with mixed sand or hogs fuel footing. Indoor warm-up is mixed sand or hogs fuel footing. USDF Introductory Level tests ridden in 20m x 40m arena; USEF Training Level may be ridden in 20m x 40m or 20m x 60m; all others ridden in 20m x 60m arena.
