ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

All tests will be ridden in a 20m x 60m arena with sand footing. Indoor or outdoor competition and/or warm-up arenas may be used.

Camping on grounds

Campers/RVs/Tents \$27 per day. Please contact show manager with questions.

Children & Pets

NO dogs; please, for safety, no unattended **children**.

Food

Concessions available on grounds.

Stabling

Permanent covered stalls with full doors available. \$25 per day or \$65 for the weekend (Thursday through Sunday 6:00 PM). Initial bedding not provided. Feed and bedding available for purchase. Purchase through Horse Park separately, do not send fee with entry - they will issue you a 'credit card' for your stabling. Contact online via www.idahohorsepark.com or phone (208) 442-3335.

AWARDS

Ribbons through fifth. Awards presented to high score IALHA registered horse. See page R-10 for eligibility requirements.

DIRECTIONS

I-84 to exit 38, Garrity exit, in Nampa, Idaho. North on Garrity through a set of lights and turn right before the railroad tracks. Check in at the office on the right before you get to stabling.

ENTRIES

Helpful hint: please print your contact e-mail address on the bottom of your entry form. Better yet, put all of your contact information on a white computer label and affix to your entry form instead of handwriting in the tiny boxes.

All entries will be processed in postmark order. However, Introductory Tests A and B will be offered only if space is available at close of entries. That is: all entries for classes 1 and 2 will be waitlisted until closing date. At that time, if at least 3 ride times remain, the classes will be offered, and filled in postmark order. If there are not sufficient ride times available at close of entries, classes 1 and 2 will be cancelled, and those entry fees refunded. If you enter class 1 and/or 2, we recommend that you send a separate check for those class fees, to facilitate refunds if these classes are not offered.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

A ride schedule will be available on the official show website, www.nwaha.org upon completion of scheduling. If a written confirmation is needed, include SASE with entry.

VOLUNTEERING

Each rider (or a suitable representative) will be required to volunteer two hours of time. Please contact show manager for details or indicate volunteer preference on entry form.
