Class Fees

- All ridden classes, including *Materiale* \$40
- In-Hand classes \$30
- Post-entries, if space available double class fees

Miscellaneous Fees

- USEF drug & admin. fees, required for *each horse* \$12
 - USDF Region 6 fee, required for *each entry* (horse/rider combination) \$ 1
 - ODS awards fee, required for *each entry* \$ 2
 - Office fee, required for *each entry, non-refundable* \$15
 - Incomplete entry fee \$35
 - Change fee, for each change made after closing date \$10
 - Returned check fee \$40
- USEF and/or USDF non-member, discipline, and/or affidavit fees will also apply unless copies of required documents are provided as specified under DOCUMENTATION at the front of this yellow section.*

- Horse stall or Tack stall, per night \$35
- Haul-in fee, for horses not stabled on grounds, per horse, per day \$10
- Overnight parking / Camping / RV hookup, per night \$20

Refunds

Until closing date: all fees refunded, less \$30 cancellation fee.

50% of Class Fees refunded if letter from vet or doctor
presented.

6/16-6/27: all Miscellaneous Fees and Stabling Fees refunded;
50% refund of Class Fees if letter from vet or doctor is presented
and if we are able to fill your ride time(s) from a waiting list.

No refunds after 6/28. All letters must be submitted by July 6 for refunds.

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Indoor competition arena and adjacent indoor warm-up have dirt/wood shavings footing. Outdoor lungeing seasonally available.

Camping on grounds

Any vehicle or trailer anywhere on the grounds that is occupied overnight will be charged \$20/night. No additional charge for electrical hook-ups only.

Food

Food will be available on grounds during meal hours only.

Stabling

Stabling, \$35/night. Box stalls with full doors, first bedding (shavings) included. No bedding in tack stalls. Additional bedding may be purchased on site. Please note stabling requests on entry. No stalls assigned without a completed entry and all fees paid. No trailer parking in lot between arena and stable.

AWARDS

Prizes to first place, ribbons through sixth. Membership may be required for breed-sponsored awards.

DIRECTIONS

I-5 to exit #9, 179TH St/Battle Ground. West on 179TH to Equestrian Entrance sign. Left on 2ND Ave to end. Left into fairgrounds at gate. Show office phone: (360) 696-0516.

ENTRIES

In-hand entries: No loose foals. 1st and 2nd placed horses in Prospect or Breeding Stock classes eligible for respective Championship classes. Champion and Reserve are eligible for Best Young Horse or Best Mature Horse classes. 1st and 2nd from Best classes eligible for LP Grand Champion class. Classes #334, 339, 343 and 345 are USDFBC Series Qualifiers.

Individual breed classes: a copy of horse's registration papers (or breeding certificate for current year foals) required. Current owner must match owner on entry form.

Incomplete entry fee applies to missing information such as horse info, registration papers (required for IBC classes), copies of current cards for horse, handler or rider, owner or trainer, required signatures or missing payment.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

No ride times will be mailed. Tentative schedule available on website after 6/19. Verify at show office. Class scheduling may require changing order of classes.
