ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Outdoor sand arenas for competition and warm-up. Introductory Level will be scheduled in small arena; Training Level through First Level Test 1 may be scheduled in small or standard arena; all others scheduled in standard arena. Schooling permitted in designated arenas until 7:00 p.m.. Indoor arena not available to show riders.

Children & Pets

NO DOGS ALLOWED - no exceptions. All children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian and be under control.

Food

Concession on grounds.

RV Hookups/Camping

Dry camping: no fee.

Stabling

Initial bedding provided; additional bedding available for purchase. Stabling for Show #1 should be available AFTER 1 p.m. on Friday and AFTER 5 p.m. on Saturday for Show #2 on Sunday. Call the secretary for early arrival requests.
