ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Tests will be ridden outdoors unless weather is very inclement. Outdoor competition arena is 20m x 60m, all-weather sand, Nike shoe, and crumb rubber footing. Indoor warm-up arena is sand, Nike shoe, and crumb rubber footing. If competition is moved indoors due to inclement weather, all tests will be ridden on a 20m x 40m arena. Introductory level tests may be ridden in a 20m x 40m arena, (judge’s discretion) either indoors or outdoors .

DIRECTIONS

Exit I-5 North or South at Corvallis exit. Take Rt. 34 west to Corvallis. Turn left on 4th St (Highway 99W) in Corvallis (2nd left after bridge). Stay on 99W 3 miles south to Airport Road – turn right. Stay on Airport Rd. for 6 miles, passing intersections at Bellfountain and Fern Roads. When road comes to a T, turn right (gravel road). In ½ mile turn right on Sexton Road at Inavale Farm sign. Farm entrance on left ¼ mile. Parking area in field near entrance gate.
