Rider's cost includes all lessons, stall and first bedding and camping spot at camp. This year we will set up a common cooking area and offer simple breakfast items and coffee. Campers will be responsible for their main meals, snacks and drinks. Springfield is only minutes away for restaurant dining or shopping for food items. You are welcome to use our camp kitchen for preparing meals. We will have Coleman cook stoves and a barbeque set up. Sorry no people showers this year. But, there is a wonderful horse shower in the main barn that we can use. Port-a-Potty and Hand Washing area will be provided. Electricity is available.

Riders are required to bring everything they need to care for their own horse while at camp. A stall and first bedding is provided. Additional bedding will be available at cost. Water is available for your horse. Your tack and feed will need to be stored in your horse trailer. You will need to bring your own muck bucket and scooper. Bring all your own personal care items. You may want to bring a cooler with ice. You will need to bring your own snacks and drinks.

More information about camp will be provided throughout the coming months to keep you up to date. When we know how many riders we will provide a riding schedule and camp out line.

This camp is designed for the adult rider to have concentrated away time with your horse.

You will be riding at least twice a day. There will be some lectures, quadrille practice and time for visiting with friends new and old.
