ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

All tests ridden in 20m x 60m competition arena. Indoor arena is wood products; outdoor arena is sand. Warm-up: grass field, dirt track and 20m x 60m outdoor sand arena. Grass lungeing area.

Children & Pets

Dogs must be leashed and children supervised by an adult.

Food

Concessions on grounds and a variety of restaurants nearby.

Camping

"Dry" campsites are plentiful for \$10 per day; power and water can be set up for \$25 per day. Please note on your entry "dry" or "power".

Smoking

LOH is a smoke-free facility. No smoking anywhere on the grounds or inside the facility.

Stabling

Stalls must be ordered well in advance; please book early.

All stalls are box stalls with full doors. Fee includes first bedding (shavings or straw); no bedding in tack stalls. Stalls may not be resold or sublet by exhibitors. Stallions must be stabled in the Main Barn.

Portables box stall with dutch doors, first bedding provided **\$145**

Tack stalls (no bedding, not available in main barn) **\$100**

Short term stalls (Sorry, no overnight, Main Barn or Portables), per day..... **\$60**

Indicate your stabling preference on your entry form; however, be aware that *stall assignments will be based on the horse's size, gender, and length of stay*. Bagged shavings are available for \$8 per bag and Hay is available for purchase for \$22 for a bale of Timothy or \$20 for a bale of Alfalfa.

AWARDS

Prize to first place, ribbons through 5th. High point award to Junior, Adult Amateur and Open (Frestyle scores do not count). Class 211 will be the USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal class. See page R-10 for eligibility requirements.

DIRECTIONS

From the north: I-5 south to Hwy 217 exit (#292); left onto Kruse Way to end. Right onto Boones Ferry Rd. Left onto Reese Rd; left onto Upper Drive. Lake Oswego Hunt Club is on the left, just past the traffic circle. **From the south:** I-5 to Lake Oswego Exit (#290). Right onto Boones Ferry Rd; right onto Reese Rd; left onto Upper Drive. Lake Oswego Hunt Club is on the left, just past the traffic circle.
