## **ABOUT THE FACILITY**

### **Arenas & Footing**

Indoor competition arena, dirt improved with sand and sawdust. Covered warm-up arena, dirt footing. Intro-Training Level Test 2 ridden in 20m x 40m short arena; all other tests ridden in 20m x 60m standard arena.

### **Children and Pets**

Yamhill County Fairgrounds allows leashed dogs on grounds. Small children must be under the control of a parent or guardian.

### **Food**

Concessions on grounds.

### **RV Hookups/Camping**

Hookups are \$15/day, please make reservations and pay in full with entry.

### **Stabling**

*Horse or Tack Stall* box stall with full doors and initial bedding (shavings)

Friday evening arrivals okay. \$35.

Prize to first place for classes of 3 or more; ribbons through fifth place.
