ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Competition arena is inside with mixed sand or hogs fuel footing. Indoor warm-up is mixed sand or hogs fuel footing. Intro, Training level tests generally will be ridden in short arena unless scheduling prohibits; all other tests ridden in standard arena.

AWARDS

Only one award will be given in each open class. Split classes will receive ribbons only (1st-6th), award will go to highest percentage in entire class. USDF/Adult Team Competition medals will be awarded to each team member, high percentage and reserve high percentage ribbons in each test level. High and reserve high percentage overall awarded to individual riders in the Adult Team Competition riding Training Level and above. Six teams per division for L-24 2009 Oregon Dressage Society Regional Omnibus purposes of awarding USDF Team neck medals may be assigned by the show secretary based on number of entries.

DIRECTIONS

Take exit 258 and then turn south onto Portland Road. Turn left on Lana Avenue, cross Silverton Road and continue straight ahead into Fairgrounds.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be e-mailed Sunday prior to the competition and posted on the ODS website around this time (there will be a link from the listing for this show on the "Shows and Clinics" page). It is the competitor's responsibility to obtain ride times from the show secretary. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or reorder classes, to add or substitute judges or to make any

other change required.

VOLUNTEERING

All competitors will be required to volunteer during the show.

WHERE TO STAY

Camping: see "About the Facility." Call secretary for a list of hotels.

OTHER

If due to the popularity of the show open rides have to be restricted, priority for open rides will be given to "complete entries" in order of submission.

If open class rides become available, competitors that have already entered the show will be notified and have first priority in adding open ride classes.

List teammates on entry. All teams are required to submit a \$50 Team entry fee. Individuals wanting to be placed on a team need to submit a \$12.50 team fee. Team member is horse/rider combination. Riders must be 21 years of age or older. All but one must meet the USEF definition of an amateur. Each team may include one professional (instructor, trainer).
