Notes: \*1. Intro classes may only be entered by horse or rider in their first year of showing. Eligibility for 1 year only.

\*2. Intro A&B and Training 1&2 will be ridden in the small arena (20mx40m) unless notified otherwise.

\*3 Class 103, Maiden Horse/Rider Combination- For horse/rider combination that has not won a blue ribbon at any dressage competition at any level.

\*4. Riders must provide their own boom box and coordinate with management for sound check.

\*5 This is a schooling show class (non-recognized). These classes do not require payment of the \$1 ODS per ride fee.

**Refunds**

All refunds are at the discretion of the Secretary.

Before closing date: full refund if rides can be filled from wait list or with Vet Certificate/Doctor's letter dated prior to the show date.

After closing date: class fees and working rider fee refunded with Vet Certificate/ Doctor's letter dated prior to the show date, or if rides are filled from wait list, less \$15 cancellation fee.

Working rider fees refunded only in above situations or if you scratch and still work at the show.

**ABOUT THE FACILITY**

**Arenas & Footing**

**Horse Butte:** Two indoor arenas and one outdoor arena, all with sand footing. Round Pen. Main show arena is lighted indoor arena. Lunging in designated areas only.

**Three Canyons:** Warm up in indoor arena, sand footing. Show arena in outdoor arena, sand footing. Round Pen. Lunging in Round Pen only.

**Future Street Farm:** Warm up in indoor arena, sand footing. Show arena in outdoor arena, sand footing. Round Pen. Lunging in Round Pen only.

NO DOGS ALLOWED any of the facilities. Children must be supervised.

Ribbons to sixth place. High Score Ribbon for each level. IF YOU WANT YOUR SCORES TO COUNT TOWARD COC YEAR END AWARDS YOU MUST DECLARE YOUR AFFILIATION WITH COC TO ODS!

**ENTRIES**

The first opening date is for COCODS Members who include with entry, as required, a copy of your ODS card showing membership. The second opening date is for General ODS Members and Non Members. COC members that do not get their entries in on the first 2 days will be entered in the order received with all other entries. Non COC and Non members that send entries on first opening date will not be penalized, but will be put on a wait list for the second opening date. PLEASE EMAIL/CALL SECRETARY IF YOU NEED CLARIFICATION ON THIS!!

**SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES**

Will be sent by e-mail (telephone as second choice.). IF you prefer to receive information by telephone, please specify, otherwise all information- times etc will be emailed. It is ultimately the responsibility of the rider to get his/her times! As classes may be scheduled out of listed order, riders should be prepared to ride at any time. Class order will vary according to entries and facilities, and tests may not be in order!

**WORKING RIDER PROGRAM**

A \$10 Working Rider fee is to be paid for EACH HORSE (members and non members) entered in the show. Please send working rider form and a separate check for each horse made out to COCODS. For each 2 hours worked by the rider or a suitable substitute, the Working Rider check will be returned. All efforts will be made to schedule rides and jobs so that they are compatible and, where possible, to have a stall available for your horse while you work. Use section on Entry form for "Other Fees." Entries will not be considered valid unless all competitors pay this fee with their entry.

**OTHER**

Management reserves all rights.

Copy of ODS card REQUIRED for scores to count toward COC awards, you must declare your affiliation with Central Oregon Chapter to ODS office prior to the show!

A horse/rider combination may only enter each test once (ie you may only ride Training Level Test 1 Maiden, and not Test 1 Amateur also).

Each rider is limited to 6 classes/2 or more horses.

Horses not entered in the show are NOT allowed on the show grounds.

Helmets are required for riders under 18 years of age.

Competitor number MUST be worn on your horse all all times while on the show grounds - this is a USEF rule!
