- Post-entries, if space available double class fees

Miscellaneous Fees

- USEF drug & admin. fees, required for *each horse*..... \$15
 - USDF Region 6 fee, required for *each entry* (horse/rider combination) \$ 1
 - ODS awards fee, required for *each ride or sporthorse go* \$ 1
 - Office fee, required for *each entry, non-refundable* \$20
 - Incomplete entry fee \$35
 - Change fee, for each change made after closing date..... \$10

Refunds

- All refunds are subject to discretion of the management.
- A \$30 cancellation fee will be deducted from all refunds.**
- Until closing date: all fees refunded.
- 6/7-6/14: all Miscellaneous Fees and Stabling Fees refunded;
50% of Class Fees refunded if letter from vet or doctor presented.
- 6/15-6/24: all Miscellaneous Fees and Stabling Fees refunded;
50% refund of Class Fees if letter from vet or doctor is presented
and if we are able to fill your ride time(s) from a waiting list.
- No refunds after 6/24. All letters must be submitted by July 6 for refunds.

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Indoor competition arena and adjacent indoor warm-up have dirt/wood shavings footing. Outdoor lungeing seasonally available.

Camping on grounds

Any vehicle or trailer anywhere on the grounds that is occupied overnight will be charged \$25/night. No additional charge electrical for hook-ups only. Overnighters please park in areas south of arena.

Food

Food will be available on grounds *during meal hours only*.

Parking

No trailer parking in lot between arena and stable. Unloading/loading only by barns. Overnight trailer parking is on the south side of the arena. Please follow posted signage.

Stabling

\$40/night, horse stall or tack stall. Permanent box stalls with full doors, minimum 10x10, first bedding (shavings) included. Additional bedding may be purchased on site. Please note "stall with" requests on entry. **Stalls available after noon Thursday.** Fairgrounds rule: no nails in stabling area. Stabling must be vacated 2 hours after end of classes on Sunday unless prior arrangements are made with show management.

AWARDS

Prizes to first place, ribbons through sixth. Champion & Reserve Champion ribbons for top score at each level (only one score per entry per day). Class 211 AA will be the USDF/ Dover Adult Amateur Medal class. See page R-10 for eligibility requirements.

DIRECTIONS

I-5 to exit #9, 179TH St/Battle Ground. West on 179TH to Equestrian Entrance sign. Left on 2ND Ave to end. Left into fairgrounds at gate. Show office phone: (360) 696-0516.

ENTRIES

Entry confirmations posted on website.

Oversubscription of entries may require lottery method. Each day is one lottery. Lotteries will be held at 11:00 AM each Sunday after opening date for the prior week at Fatty Patty's in Battle Ground, WA.

\$35 Incomplete entry fee applies to missing information such as horse info, registration papers required for IBC classes or breed awards, copies of current cards for horse, handler or rider, owner, trainer or coach, required signatures or missing and/or significant underpayment.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

No ride times will be mailed. Tentative ride times available at www.dovecreekonline.com after 6/20. Changes will be posted as necessary, check before show begins. Order of classes may vary. Verify times at show office as schedule may be modified due to scratches, post entries or other changes. Class scheduling may require changing order of classes.

Warning! This is a one-ring show. Performance hours may be 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM. Two judges will be used. Classes will be assigned per license status, then the odd test in the first part of the day and the even tests in the later half. This is always subject to the number of entries.
