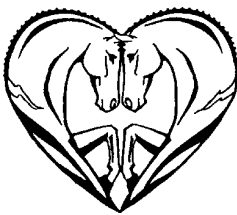

A \$30 cancellation fee will be deducted from all refunds

- Until closing date: all refundable fees returned.
- 4/24 - 5/5: all miscellaneous and stabling fees refunded; 50% of class fees refunded if doctor or vet note is provided and if we are able to fill your ride time from the wait list.
- 5/6 - 5/13: all refunds at the discretion of show management, doctor or vet note required.
- After 5/13: no refunds.

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

We will be running three competition arenas, an indoor sand 20m x 60m with indoor sand warm-up, an outdoor sand 20m x 60m with sand warm-up and and one outdoor hog fuel 20m X 60m. Schooling in the competition arenas will be allowed Friday before grooming and Saturday evening after the show, prior to grooming. **Lungeing allowed ONLY in large, hog fuel area next to lower stabling.** No lungeing in warm-ups or round pens.

Children & Pets

Absolutely NO DOGS ALLOWED on show grounds. Children must be supervised at all times.

Food

Concessions will be available on show grounds.

Parking

Reserved parking is available on a first come, first served basis for \$40/weekend. ENTIRE rig must fit within space, both length and width, to ensure clear fire lane. Competitor must display parking pass in vehicle. Electric hookups are available as a courtesy at the end of each stabling row (first come, first served) and may be used between the hours of 7 pm through 7 am.

Stabling

Permanent box stalls with full doors - Upper Barn 12'x12'; Lower barns: Barn E/F has 10'x12'; Barns C/D and G/H have 10'x10'. Initial bedding provided, none in tack stalls. Additional bedding available for purchase on site. Bedding other than shavings or pellets prohibited. *Stalls may not be resold or sublet by exhibitors.* Indicate stabling preference on entry, but realize that stalls will be assigned based on horse's size, gender and length of stay, not just on postmark date. **Stalls available Friday noon through Sunday evening.**

AWARDS

Awards to first, ribbons through sixth place. Class 111/211 will be the USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal class. See page R-10 for eligibility requirements.

DIRECTIONS

I-5 south from Portland/north from Salem to Sherwood/Tualatin exit, #289. West on Nyberg Road (Nyberg Road becomes Tualatin/Sherwood Hwy) and go five miles to Hwy 99W. Turn south and go three miles to 25033 SW Pacific Hwy, on your right just past Brookman/Chapman Rd.

ENTRIES

Each day is a separate show and requires a separate entry.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Classes may be split or combined at show management's discretion.

Ride times will be e-mailed to riders and posted at www.foxvillage.com. If you would prefer your ride times to be mailed in hard copy, please enclose a self addressed, stamped envelope with your entry. Show management reserves the right to combine or split classes, substitute judges or add arenas as necessary.
