**Refunds**

**A \$25 cancellation fee will be deducted from all refunds.**

Stabling: if cancelled prior to 5/21, cancelled stalls refunded less a \$20/stall or tack room processing fee. NO REFUNDS FOR DAY OF SHOW CANCELLATIONS.

All other fees: Until 5/7: all fees refunded less cancellation fee. After 5/7: no refunds with the following exception - veterinary and/or medical certificate AND ride times have been filled.

**QUALIFICATIONS FOR ODS LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW CLASSES**

This event consists of two sections: an **Open Show** and the **ODS League Championship Show**.

1. Each horse/rider combination must have at least two qualifying scores from any test of the level at two different ODS League competitions from two different judges to qualify for each level, at a minimum score of 55% prior to the closing date. *Exception: there are no qualification requirements for the ODS League Championship Freestyle, Pas de Deux or Quadrille.*
2. Rider must be a **current ODS member** in good standing at the time score is earned.
3. For the 2010 League Championship Show, qualifying show year is **May 1, 2009 through April 30, 2010**. Score must be earned in current show year and is not transferable.
4. Only scores received at competitions designated ODS League-approved shows, using an "L" graduate or USEF licensed judge count.

5. Qualifying score must be earned by horse/rider combination; it cannot be earned separately.
6. **In order to establish your qualification for championship classes, you must attach photocopy(s) of the front cover of the qualifying test(s) to the entry form. Also enclose a copy of your ODS membership card.**
7. Open show classes will be run under ODS League Show Rules; Championship show classes will be run under ODS Championship Show Rules as modified by the section "Championship Rules," below. Championship classes must **be ridden from memory**, and **whips are not** allowed.
8. Horse/rider combinations may entry two levels but may only ride in one division (Adult, Open or Junior Young Rider).

## **ABOUT THE FACILITY**

---

### **Arenas & Footing**

Two competition arenas and one warm-up arena, all 20m x 60m with dirt/woodwaste footing. All arenas are covered.

### **Camping on Grounds**

\$35/night, no tents permitted. Electrical hook-ups available. All vehicles (including trailers) using RV spaces must pay camping fee and have "PAID" camping card visible in vehicle window at show.

### **Food**

Concessions on grounds.

### **Stabling**

Full door, 10'x10' box stalls on grounds (includes initial bedding). Additional bedding may be purchased on grounds. Haul-in fee for horses not stabled. Contact Ed Miller (541) 482-2902 or eamgroup@aol.com if you are arriving before Friday.

## **AWARDS**

---

Trophies to first place and ribbons to sixth place for the open show on Saturday. Awards to Champion and Reserve Champion and ribbons to eighth place for the League Championship show. All horses and riders placing in the championship classes must appear for their presentation ceremony to receive their awards and ribbons. There will be an overall High Point ribbon and award for the horse/rider combination with the highest combined percentage for the open show on Saturday. In the event of a tie other than for the Champion, the "collective" scores will determine the winner, if these equal the tie will remain unbroken. If collective marks for champion are equal, the tie will remain unbroken (i.e. two first places will be awarded, next third place, etc.). Only ties for Champion will remain unbroken. The sponsorship coordinator requests that all winners sign a Thank You note to their respective sponsors; Thank You notes will be located at the awards booth.

## **CHAMPIONSHIP RULES**

---

1. **Championship classes must be ridden from memory (no callers).**
2. **Whips are not permitted in Championship classes.**
3. ODS League Show attire rules must be followed (see the "Green General Section" in the *Omnibus* or view these requirements online). Juniors are required to wear ASTM-SEI approved helmets with harness.
4. Entrants or their designees are required to volunteer (see Volunteering below).
5. ODS League Show rules apply.
6. Management reserves the right to change show format, cancel or combine classes as entries warrant.

## **DIRECTIONS**

---

Take I-5 to Central Point exit (#33). If coming from the north, take a left after taking exit, turn left at the second light onto Penniger Road, then turn right at livestock gate #5. If coming from the south, turn right after taking the exit, immediately get into the left lane, turn left at the light onto Penniger Road and turn right at livestock gate #5.

## **ENTRIES**

---

Entries for the League Championship Show will not be accepted without proper verification of eligibility. Entries must be accompanied by photocopies of the front of score sheets for qualifying rides.

## **LEVELS / DIVISIONS**

---

Horse/Rider combinations may enter two consecutive levels but may only ride in one division (Adult Amateur, Junior/Young Rider, etc.). Refer to USEF rules in regards to Adult Amateur and Junior/Young Rider definitions. Horses may not be cross entered between Open / AA or Open /Jr/YR.

## **SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES**

---

Ride times will be e-mailed and posted on the ODS website (there will be a link from the listing for this show on the "Shows and Clinics" page). It is the competitors responsibility to obtain ride times from the show secretary. Management reserves the right to combine, cancel or reorder classes, add or substitute judges or make any other changes required.

## **SCORING**

---

Championship scores will be calculated by dividing total points earned in the two tests by the total of the points available in those tests.
