**ABOUT THE FACILITY**

**Arenas & Footing**

Competition arena is inside with mixed sand or hogs fuel footing. Indoor warm-up is mixed sand or hogs fuel footing. **Intro, Training level tests generally will be ridden in short arena unless scheduling prohibits**; all other tests ridden in standard arena.

**Dogs**

No dogs.

**Food**

No concessions available.

**RV Hookups/Camping**

Full hookups available for \$25/day, electrical only hookups for \$20/day or no hookup camping is \$15/day.

**Stabling**

Horse Stall box stalls with full doors, wood shavings for bedding provided.

**AWARDS**

Prize to first place, ribbons through sixth. Only ribbons presented for classes with fewer than four rides.

**DIRECTIONS**

Take exit 258 and then turn south onto Portland Road. Turn left on Lana Avenue, cross Silverton Road and continue straight ahead into Fairgrounds.
