Refunds

A \$30 cancellation fee will be deducted from all refunds.

Until closing date: all monies refunded less the non-refundable fees.

After closing date: refund as follows **only with letter from doctor or veterinarian.**

All miscellaneous and facility fees refunded. Class fees refunded at the discretion of the show management.

Refunds will be mailed after the show.

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Indoor competition arena 20m x 60m; Training Level may be scheduled in 20m x 40m arena. Indoor warm-up arena *next to competition arena*. Both arenas have dirt/wood shavings footing. Outdoor lungeing seasonally available.

Camping on grounds

Any vehicle or trailer anywhere on the grounds that is occupied overnight will be charged \$25/night. No additional charge for hook-ups. Electricity hookups available on the south side of arena building.

Children & Pets

Dogs must be kept leashed; **children** must be supervised by an adult.

Food

Food will be available on grounds.

Parking

No trailer parking in lot between arena and stable. Unloading/loading only by barns. Overnight trailer parking is on the south side of the arena. Please follow posted signage.

Stabling

\$40/night, horse stall or tack stall. Permanent box stalls with full doors, minimum 10x10, first bedding (shavings) included. Additional bedding may be purchased on site. Please note "stall with" requests on entry. **Stalls available after noon Thursday.**

Fairgrounds rule: no nails in stabling area.

Stabling must be vacated 2 hours after end of classes on Sunday unless prior arrangements are made with show management.

AWARDS

Awards to 1st, ribbons through 6th. Class 211 will be the USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal class. See page R-10 for eligibility requirements.

DIRECTIONS

I-5 to exit #9, 179TH Street/Battle Ground. West on 179TH to Equestrian Entrance sign. Left on 2ND Avenue to end. Left into fairgrounds at gate.

ENTRIES

Management may limit the number of horses a rider enters in the same class(es). *Management reserves the right to refuse or require withdrawal of an entry for cause deemed sufficient by show management.*

Incomplete entry fee applies to missing information such as horse info, copies of current cards for horse, handler or rider, owner or trainer, required signatures or missing payment.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be e-mailed to riders 5-7 days prior to show and posted at www.foxvilleage.com. However, responsibility for obtaining ride times from show management remains with the competitor.
