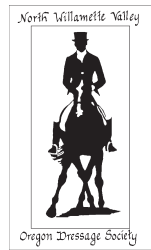

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Indoor competition and warm-up arenas. Lightfoot™ footing; sand and Geotek fabric mixed with nylon, rubber and foam. Intro Level tests ridden in short 20m x 40m court. Training level tests may be scheduled in either short or standard 20m x 60m court. Musical rides to be ridden in standard court. Costume class may be held in short court.

Food

Food will be available on grounds.

Stabling

Box stalls with full doors. First bedding is included; additional bedding available for purchase. Please note any stabling requests on entry form. **Stalls available after 2pm Friday.**

AWARDS

Awards to first place; ribbons through sixth place.

DIRECTIONS

Hwy 26 east toward Sandy. Right onto Haley Road then hard left onto Lariat Lane. Hwy 212 east to Boring, left on 282nd, right on Haley Road and straight onto Lariat Lane.

PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR

Every rider, when riding anywhere on the show grounds, must wear a protective helmet with harness fastened. Riders who refuse to do so must immediately dismount, and both the rider and the horse will be disqualified from the competition. No scores for that horse will be reported, and no refunds will be issued.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be e-mailed to riders before the show and posted at www.foxvillage.com. Scheduling may require changing the order of classes. Management reserves the right to drop or combine classes, substitute judges or change classes to a another day.

VOLUNTEERS

All volunteers will be welcomed and appreciated.

WHERE TO STAY

Camping on grounds or call show secretary for suggestions.

OTHER

Local show rules may apply; check with show management. *Riders required to wear protective headgear while mounted (please see page L-5)*. Entries will not be accepted without full payment and proper signatures. No phone/fax entries. Entries postmarked by closing date may purchase scratches without penalty.

129 Costume class - this is a costume test of choice class. Any USDF Introductory level test or USEF Training, First or Second level test may be ridden. Since additional points are available and show attire rules do not apply, scores will not be counted towards year end awards or championship qualification. Over the Rainbow theme - up to 10 additional points for that colorful look for you and your horse. General league show rules apply to biting, saddlery, spurs, and whips. League show rules concerning horse and rider attire do not apply. Horse boots and wraps may be worn. Decorations in the mane and tail and elsewhere are permitted. The color of the rider attire, saddle pads and horse need not be "conservative." Boots with a heel are required. ASTM helmets are required. Management will reserve the right to refuse the ride for any aspect of the costume deemed unsafe, such as robes which might trip the horse, become caught in the arena, etc. Every attempt will be made to schedule "Over the Rainbow" costume freestyle class during prime time on Saturday afternoon, probably immediately following the lunch break. If you enter more than one class on Saturday and this is one of them, please let us know how much time you need to decorate/undecorate your horse.
