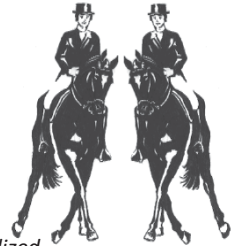

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Competition arena is inside with mixed sand or hogs fuel footing. Indoor warm-up is mixed sand or hogs fuel footing. Intro, Training level tests generally will be ridden in 20m x 40m short arena unless scheduling prohibits; all other tests ridden in standard 20m x 40m arena.

Competitors Party - We will have a dinner for team competitors and friends. Competitors are \$6.50; non-competitors will be \$10.50. The time for dinner will be announced at the show, but we anticipate it will be sometime between 6 - 7 pm. Please pre-order your meal.

AWARDS

Only one award will be given in each open class. Split classes will receive ribbons only (1st-6th), award will go to highest percentage in entire class.

Six teams per division for purposes of awarding USDF Team neck medals may be randomly assigned by the show secretary based on number of entries. USDF/Adult Team Competition medals will be awarded to each team member, high percentage and reserve high percentage ribbons in each test level. **High and reserve high percentage overall awarded to individual riders in the Adult Team Competition riding Training Level and above.**

DIVISION HIGH PERCENT: The highest test ridden in the Test Division will count for the High Percent award. An award will be presented to the highest percent and reserve high percent rider in each Test Division. (i.e. all riders riding Division C - Training level test 1 & 2 – the riders with the highest test 2 scores will receive High percent and reserve High percent awards)

DIRECTIONS

Take exit 258 and then turn south onto Portland Road. Turn left on Lana Avenue, cross Silverton Road and continue straight ahead into Fairgrounds.

DIVISIONS

Class Division: The two tests, which a rider rides, is the division the rider is competing in. The average of the two tests will determine the placing of the rider in the division. USDF Rosettes are awarded to an individual High Percentage Champion and Reserve Champion in each class division and ribbons will be placed through eighth place. If the division is a large division the show reserves the right to split the division.

Team Division: Teams are comprised of three or four-horse rider combinations and they may ride different division tests. There is only 6 teams per team divisions. Team ribbons are awarded for 6 places so all riders will receive a team ribbon. You may also have one professional on your team. After entries are all in, teams will be divided into Team Divisions based on a point system where each test ridden is given a value and the teams will be placed in team divisions by their team's total score.

ENTRIES

If due to the popularity of the show open rides have to be restricted, priority for open rides will be given to "complete entries" in order of submission.

If open class rides become available, competitors that have already entered the show will be notified and have first priority in adding open ride classes.

Competitors may compete on more than one horse on different teams and divisions. For sportsmanship reasons do not enter divisions more than one test lower than what you have been showing.

All teams with the complete and correct entries - including sponsorships will be given priority on ride time requests. Incomplete entries, entries submitted without sponsor and/or sponsor money will be returned to the competitor.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be e-mailed Sunday prior to the competition and posted on the ODS website's news page around this time. It is the competitor's responsibility to obtain ride times from the show secretary. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or reorder classes, to add or substitute judges or to make any other change required.

On Sunday, all competitors must be present for the Awards Ceremony on Sunday, only exception is with prior approval from show manager or secretary. A team member must pick up the awards for you they will not be mailed.

SCORING

On teams of four, the lowest average score will be dropped. For teams of three, all scores will count. (refer to information below on teams) Remember team members do not all have to ride the same tests to be on the same team if you have questions please contact the Gaye McCabe.

TEAMS

List teammates on entry or separate piece of paper and enclose with entry. Please also include a team name. All teams are required to submit a \$50 Team entry fee. Team member is horse/rider combination. Riders must be 21 years of age or older. All but one must meet the USEF definition of an amateur. Each team may include one professional (instructor, trainer).

If you do not have a team and would like to be part of the team competition send your entry in and you will be place with others to help form a team. Individuals wanting to be placed on a team need to submit a \$12.50 team fee.

VOLUNTEERING

All competitors will be required to volunteer during the show. Please indicate on your entry any special position you would like to fill.
