Until Closing Date: all refundable fees returned.

After Closing Date: if entry cancelled on closing date or later, any refund is at the discretion of show management and only if a medical/vet certificate is supplied and we are able to fill your ride time from the wait list.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR ODS LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW CLASSES

This event consists of three sections: an **Open Show** the **ODS League Championship Show** and the **Oregon High School Championship**.

1. Each horse/rider combination must have at least two qualifying scores from any test of the level at two different ODS approved League competitions from two different judges to qualify for each level, at a minimum score of 55% prior to the closing date. *Exception: there are no qualification requirements for the ODS League Championship Freestyle, Pas de Deux or Quadrille or for the Oregon High School Championship.*
2. Rider must be a **current ODS member** in good standing at the time score is earned. Riders entered in the Oregon High School Championship must be a enrolled in an official ODS High School Team in good standing.
3. For the 2012 League Championship Show, qualifying show year is **May 1, 2011 through April 30, 2012**. Score must be earned in current show year and is not transferable.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR ODS LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW CLASSES, CONT'D

4. Only scores received at competitions designated ODS League-approved shows, using an "L" graduate or USEF licensed judge count.
5. Qualifying score must be earned by horse/rider combination; they cannot be earned separately.
6. **In order to establish your qualification for championship classes, you must attach photocopies of the front cover of the qualifying tests to the entry form. Also enclose proof of your ODS membership.**
7. Open show classes will be run under ODS League Show Rules; Championship show classes will be run under ODS Championship Show Rules as modified by the section "Championship Rules," below. Championship classes must **be ridden from memory**, and **whips are not** allowed.
8. Horse/rider combinations may entry two levels but may only ride in one division (Adult, Open or Junior Young Rider).
9. If a horse rider combination wins a Championship with fewer than 3 in the class then horse/rider combination is eligible to compete in Championship at same level the following year, provided the qualifying criteria are met.
10. **A horse may be entered in ODS League Championship Classes by two different riders provided both riders are competing in the same division (JR/YR, AA or Open) and at consecutive levels. All other rules apply.**

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Two competition arenas and one warm-up arena, all 20m x 60m with dirt/woodwaste footing. All arenas are covered.

Camping on Grounds

Full hookups available for \$35/day, electrical only hookups for \$25/day or no hookup camping is \$15/day. If you use an electrical hookup at any time, you will be charged the daily hookup fee. All vehicles (including trailers) using RV spaces must pay camping fee and have "PAID" camping card visible in vehicle window at show.

Food

No concessions available.

Stabling

Horse box stalls with full doors, wood shavings for bedding provided. Weekend fee is for Friday through Sunday. Haul in fee applies for horses not stabled.

AWARDS

Trophies to first place and ribbons to sixth place for the open show on Saturday. Awards to Champion and Reserve Champion and ribbons to eighth place for the League Championship show section. All horses and riders placing in the championship classes must appear for their presentation ceremony to receive their awards and ribbons. There will be an overall High Point ribbon and award for the horse/rider combination with the highest combined percentage for the open show on Saturday. In the event of a tie other than for the Champion, the "collective" scores will determine the winner, if these remain equal the tie will remain unbroken. If collective marks for champion are equal, the tie

will remain unbroken (i.e. two first places will be awarded, next third place, etc.). Only ties for Champion will remain unbroken. The sponsorship coordinator requests that all winners sign a Thank You note to their respective sponsors; Thank You notes will be located at the office.

CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. **Championship classes must be ridden from memory (no callers).**
2. **Whips are not permitted in Championship classes.**
3. ODS League Show attire rules must be followed (see the "Green General Section" in the *Omnibus* or view these requirements online). See also *Helmet Rule* below.
4. Entrants or their designees are required to volunteer. See also *Volunteering* below.
5. ODS League Show rules apply.
6. Management reserves the right to change show format, cancel or combine classes as entries warrant.
7. **A horse may be entered in ODS League Championship Classes by two different riders provided both riders are competing in the same division (JR/YR, AA or Open) and at consecutive levels. All other rules apply.**

DIRECTIONS

Take exit 258 and then turn south onto Portland Road. Turn left on Lana Avenue, cross Silverton Road and continue straight ahead into Fairgrounds.

ENTRIES

Entries for the League Championship Show will not be accepted without proper verification of eligibility. Entries must be accompanied by photocopies of the front of score sheets for qualifying rides.

HELMET RULE

Every rider, trainer or coach, when riding anywhere on the show grounds must wear a protective helmet with harness fitted. Riders who refuse to do so must immediately dismount and both the rider and the horse will be disqualified from the competition. No scores for that horse will be reported and no refunds will be issued.

LEVELS / DIVISIONS

Horse/Rider combinations may enter two consecutive levels but may only ride in one division (Adult Amateur, Junior/Young Rider, etc.). Refer to USEF rules in regards to Adult Amateur and Junior/Young Rider definitions. Horses may not be cross entered between Open / AA or Open /Jr/YR. Please note that High School riders may enter the ODS League Championship divisions as well as the High School Championship.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be e-mailed and posted on the ODS website's news page and Fox Village. It is the competitor's responsibility to obtain ride times from the show secretary. Management reserves the right to combine, cancel or reorder classes, add or substitute judges or make any other changes required.

SCORING

Championship scores will be calculated by dividing total points earned in the two tests by the total of the points available in those tests.

VOLUNTEERING

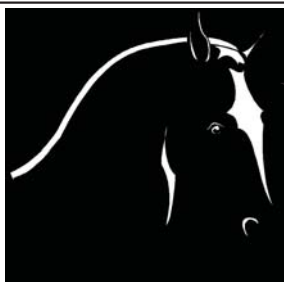
