About the Facility

Arenas & Footing

Indoor competition arena, sand improved with rubber and granite, covered warm-up arena with dirt footing, outdoor warm-up arena with sand footing & round pen available for lunging. NO LUNGING IN WARM-UP ARENAS! All tests will be ridden in a standard arena.

Children & Pets

Small children must be under control and Please NO DOGS.

Food

Curbside Grill Express will be providing concessions on grounds.

Directions

From the North I-5 to Exit Valley View(exit 21) off ramp make a right 2 signals, 2nd signal make a left onto Hwy 99 follow down to Rapp Rd make a right follow turns left into Wagner Creek Rd, (approx. 2 miles) Make a left into Cygnet Farms.

Scheduling

Ride times will be emailed; be sure to include CORRECT e-mail address. If you do not have email, please provide a phone number. However, responsibility for obtaining ride times from show management remains with the competitor.

Attire

Show attire is not required, tall or paddocks boots with half chaps may be worn and approved safety helmets for all riders. At any time while mounted on the competition grounds, all riders must wear protective headgear as defined by the USEF Rule DR120 and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.
