1. **CLASSES**

Classes may be split; Open, Junior/Young Rider, and/or Adult Amateur, as entries warrant. Please specify division on entry. Riders under 18 years of age must supply birthdate.

2. **AWARDS**

1st place: Award and ribbon; ribbons through 5th place.

3. **ENTRIES**

A completed entry is required for every horse brought onto the show grounds. Horses not entered in the show may be brought onto the grounds only with prior

permission of the show management. No telephone entries will be accepted. Late entries will be accepted only if ride time(s) are available.

4. FEES & REFUNDS

Please make checks payable to: Siskiyou Chapter/ODS. FEES: All tests \$20.00. Late entries, if accepted: add \$5.00/test. No number deposit or haul-in fee. \$5.00 change fee applies for each change to entry. \$25.00 returned check fee.

VOLUNTEER FEES: \$15.00 volunteer fee; please include a separate check to cover volunteer fee of \$15.00 per competitor. This check will be refunded upon completion of 1 hour of volunteer of service to this show. Indicate on entry form what service you would like to provide during your one hour of volunteer service.

REFUNDS: \$15.00 office fee deducted from all refunds. Refunds after closing date will be issued only with letter from vet or doctor. STABLING FEES:

\$25.00/stall for day use fee; includes 1 bag of shavings. Second horse/stall same owner/rider \$23.00 each. Third or more horses/stalls, same owner/rider \$20.00 each. Stalls are 10 x 10 with full doors, on tarmac. No straw bedding is permitted on the grounds. Limited time stalls available for use while volunteering only.

5. RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be mailed to entrants on February 3, 2005. Riders are responsible for contacting management for times if not received.

6. FOOTING & ARENAS

The Barker and Krouse arenas have sand/dirt footing. Lunging area available, weather permitting. No lunging in the warm up arena. No one on foot in the warm up arena. Dogs must be on leashes and under control at all times. Children must be under direct adult supervision at all times.

7. DIRECTIONS:

The Jackson County Exposition Park is located in Central Point, at exit #33 off of Interstate 5. Take I-5 to #33, exit to the East. Turn Left onto Penninger Road. Use gate #5.

9. OTHER: General show rules apply. Show dress is optional. Riders must be appropriately/respectfully attired. Boots are mandatory. ASTM hard hats are mandatory for Junior Riders. Leg wraps and training devices will not be permitted.

10. ENTRY FORMS: Please submit entries using the 2005 ODS League Dressage Competition Entry Form from the omnibus.
