Riders **MUST** work a **minimum of 2 hours** to receive a refund, no exceptions. Please indicate what jobs you are qualified for and what time slots you would be willing to work. Every effort will be made to schedule work times that are as convenient as we can make them. If an appropriate assigned time does not work for you, a qualified friend may be substituted, or your \$10 will not be refunded. A stall or pen will be available for worker's horses during their assigned work time, but you must provide you own hay and water, and clean up after your horse. If you sign up to work, we expect you to fulfill your obligation—we depend on you to help keep the shows running smoothly!

Please read carefully—there have been some changes!

1. **Levels** USDF Intro through FEI.
2. **Awards** Ribbons to sixth place. Hi Score Ribbon for Junior and Adult rider in each level.
3. **Entries** **COCODS Members: \$20 per test, Non-Members: \$25 per test. Pas de Deux \$20 per Team, \$25 non-members. Quadrille \$20 per Team, \$25 non-members.** Valid ODS member number required. **Must** be paid by all competitors: \$2 per horse ODS awards fee, \$2 number deposit, \$10 Working Rider fee. (See #5 below) **Entries will not be considered valid without an accurate ODS # and the Working Rider Sign up form, so please fill out the entry form carefully!! Proper signatures are also required.** Use standard ODS entry form for League shows found in the ODS Omnibus or may be downloaded at www.oregondressage.com.

4. **Refunds & Changes** Refunds before closing with veterinary certificate or if rides can be filled from waiting list. Refunds after closing *only if ride is filled from waiting list less \$10 office fee*. Changes to entry after closing (ie change of horse, rider or tests) will be charged a \$10 office fee and are at the discretion of the show secretary.
5. **Classes** Junior/Young Riders will be divided if there are 3 or more Junior/Young Riders per class (with the exception of class 4J which is for Junior/Young Riders only). Classes may be combined at the Secretary's discretion if there are less than 3 entered in a class. Introductory Level Tests and Training Level Tests 1 & 2 will be ridden in the small arena (20mx40m). Second Level and Above may be divided at the secretary's discretion.
***Each rider is limited to 6 classes/2 or more horses. If there is room 5 days before the closing date then more classes may be entered at the Secretary's discretion. Call/email Secretary for details.
6. **Working Rider Program** We require that each rider (COC members and non-members) or a suitable representative work at the show for a minimum of 2 hours. A limited number of people may also help set up before the show. At the end of the show or after you have completed your assigned job, the \$10 fee will be refunded to the rider. All efforts will be made to schedule rides and jobs so that they are compatible and, where possible, to have stalls available while you work. If a rider does not wish to work at the show, then the \$10 goes into a fund. If not enough volunteers are available to work the show, the volunteer fund will be donated to hire Pony Club, 4H or some other similar group to help at the show or to help defray costs for volunteer perks (lunch, drinks, etc.). Entries will not be considered valid unless all competitors pay the fee with their entry. **Use section on Entry form for "Other Fees."**
7. **Rules** Management reserves all rights. Horses not entered in the show are NOT allowed on the show grounds. Riders who are unable to keep their horses under control may be asked to leave the grounds and forfeit all entry fees. Please be courteous and consider the safety of others at all times. Proper show attire is encouraged. Helmet or appropriate dressage hat and boots are required. Half chaps are allowed, but not encouraged. Coaching is allowed only from outside the warm-up arena. US Equestrian rules will be in effect. Tack, bits, whips and spurs will be checked. The entire rule book is available online at: www.usef.org, then go to Rules. **NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON THE SHOWGROUNDS FACILITY AT ALL.** Children must be supervised and under control at all times.
8. **Musical Freestyle/Pas de Deux/Quadrille Classes** Training Level Freestyles are allowed. 5 minute time limit. Costumes for horse and rider are allowed. Rider must provide show management with a boom box or music playing device when they check in at the show. Will be scheduled after lunch break and will be in 20mx60m arena. Pas de Deux: 20mx60m arena. Will be scheduled in the afternoon.
Quadrille: 20mx40m arena. Will be scheduled before lunch break.
9. **Times** will be sent by e-mail (telephone as second choice.). *IF you prefer to receive information by telephone, please specify, otherwise all information- times etc will be emailed.* As classes may be scheduled out of listed order, riders should be prepared to ride at any time. The show schedule may be run in a different order than at past shows. **Tentative class order, subject to change:** 1,2,3,4,5,15, Lunch,13,14,6,7,8,9,10,11,12
10. **Stabling** Contact Horse Butte directly for information on available stabling. 388-2820
11. **Directions** From 27th St near the Knott Landfill turn left on Rickard Rd. Continue approx 2 miles, turn right on Billadeau Rd. At Stop sign, turn left on Arnold Market Rd, show grounds parking is immediately on the right, follow signs.
