Refunds

- Until closing date: all fees refunded, less \$30 cancellation fee.
 - 5/4–5/21: all Miscellaneous Fees and Stabling Fees refunded; 50% of Class Fees refunded if letter from vet or doctor presented.
 - 5/22–6/1: all Miscellaneous Fees and Stabling Fees refunded; 50% refund of Class Fees if letter from vet or doctor is presented **and** if we are able to fill your ride times from the waiting list.
- Entries withdrawn after 6/1: refunds at discretion of show management.

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Indoor competition arena 20m x 60m; Training Level may be scheduled in 20m x 40m arena. Indoor warm-up arena *next to competition arena*. Both arenas have dirt/wood shavings footing. Outdoor lungeing seasonally available.

Camping on grounds

Any vehicle or trailer anywhere on the grounds that is occupied overnight will be charged \$18.50/night. No additional charge for hook-ups.

Children & Pets

Dogs must be kept leashed; **children** must be supervised by an adult.

Food

Food will be available on grounds *during meal hours only*.

Stabling

\$35/night, horse stall or tack stall. Box stalls with full doors, first bedding (shavings) included. No bedding in tack stalls. Additional bedding may be purchased on site. Please note "stall with" requests on entry. **Stalls available after noon Thursday.** No haul-in fee, however horses on grounds overnight must be assigned a stall. No trailer parking in lot between arena and stable.

AWARDS

Trophies to 1st, ribbons through 6th. Breed awards; enclose copy of horse's breed registration with entry. Class 212 will be the USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal class. See page 10 for eligibility requirements.

DIRECTIONS

I-5 to exit #9, 179TH St/Battle Ground. West on 179TH to Equestrian Entrance sign. Left on 2ND Ave to end. Left into fairgrounds at gate.

ENTRIES

Management may limit the number of horses a rider or handler enters in the same class(es). *Management reserves the right to refuse or require withdrawal of an entry for cause deemed sufficient by show management.*

In-hand entries: complete all breeding information requested on entry form.

Group in-hand classes: enter separately in the name of mare/stallion/breeder.

Permission required if exhibitor is not stallion/mareowner or group breeder.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be mailed to riders on May 24 (no SASE required) and posted at www.DressagePro.com. However, responsibility for obtaining ride times from show management remains with the competitor.

OTHER

Farrier and veterinarian on call each show day; names and phone numbers printed in show program and posted at show office. **Scoring errors** must be reported to Show Secretary within two hours of receipt of test or error will stand with no change in class placing. **All other protests** will be handled according to the current *USEF Rule Book*, rule GR603.

Sporhorse Division: Braiding required; no loose foals. Recognized by USDF and NWSHBA; prior membership and horse recording required for points to count toward annual awards. Classes conducted according to the current *USEF Rule Book, Dressage Division, Subchapter DR-2*. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with these rules.

The owner, lessee, or organizer of this event grants the public and exhibitors license to enter upon the property or facility for the purpose of observing or participating in the event (defined in RCW 4.24.210 as an outdoor recreation limiting the liability of owners and occupiers of the land), but not otherwise. This license is subject to revocation and entry for any other purpose other than granted herein should be deemed criminal trespass subject to appropriate legal proceedings (RCW 9A48, RCW 9152).
