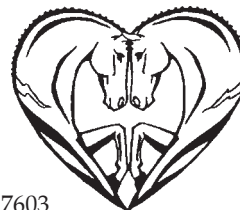

Children & Pets

Absolutely **NO DOGS ALLOWED** on show grounds.

Food

Concessions will be available on show grounds.

Stabling

Box stalls with sliding doors, initial bedding (shavings) included. No refunds on stabling fees. Extra shavings will be for sale at the show office. Stalls are on a first come basis.

ARENAS & FOOTING

We will be running two competition arenas, an indoor hog fuel 20mx60m with indoor hog fuel warm-up and an outdoor sand 20mx60m with sand warm-up. Riding in the competition arenas will be allowed Friday before grooming. **Lunging allowed ONLY in large, hog fuel area next to lower stabling.** No lunging in warm-ups or round pens.

AWARDS

Awards to first in classes with at least 3 riders, ribbons through sixth place. Class 209 will be the USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal class. See page 10 for eligibility requirements.

DIRECTIONS

I-5 south from Portland/north from Salem to Sherwood/Tualatin exit, #289. West on Nyberg Road (Nyberg Road becomes Tualatin/Sherwood Hwy) and go five miles to Hwy 99W. Turn south and go three miles to 25033 SW Pacific Hwy, on your right just past Brookman/Chapman Rd.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Classes may be split or combined at show management's discretion. Ride times will be mailed at least one week before the show; **enclose self-addressed, stamped envelope.**
